## **GROUP I.M:**

**DATES:** 17th-23rd December 2016.

**LOCATION:** Hotel CEMAR\*\*. Carretera General Pontareas - Mondariz, Km. 7 Mondariz Balneario (GALICIA) SPAIN.

**GAME SYSTEM:** Ten players Round Robin system.

**TIME CONTROL:** 90 minutes per player for the whole game, plus 30 seconds increment per move made.

### **PLAYER:**

Any active player with FIDE code can take part in this tournament, with preference to GM, MI, MF, WMF, WMI or WGM.

### **INSCRIPTION:**

Includes participation in International Closed Chess Tournament Group M.I. + Accommodation in a single room on a Full Board basis at the CEMAR \*\* Hotel, with entrance on Saturday, December 17 at 3:00 p.m. and departure on Friday, December 23 after the Closing Ceremony.

Consult General Bases of the XII International Chess Festival GEMA63.

- The tournament will be valid for International Chess Norms, ELO FIDE and ELO FEDA.
  - For the purposes of the final classification, the following tie systems will be applied and in the order indicated:  
1.- Sonnenborn - Berger. 2.- Particular result. 3.-Greater number of victories.
  - A Competition Committee will be appointed consisting of:  
Three titled players and two substitutes, previously chosen by ballot of the own players.  
(There must be between the five members a minimum of one Spanish player and one foreign player).The Tournament Director (or delegate).  
The Main Referee of the tournament.
  - Any claim will be formalized in writing and at most one hour after the event that is the subject of the claim happened.
- The player who arrives at the Game Room with more than 30 minutes of delay with respect to the scheduled start time of the round, except the first one that will be tolerated one hour late, will lose the game.  
In both cases, it will be at the discretion of the Arbiter to make the tolerance time more flexible.
  - The use of mobile telephony or any other electronic means during the game session shall not be permitted. Its use will lead to the loss of the game.
  - Once the game is over, the chess players must leave the pieces as they were found at the beginning of the game.
  - The participation in the Tournament implies that the participants authorize the publication of their personal data and image (photos, videos, etc) in the different media that the Organization deems appropriate for the necessary broadcasting of the event (list of players, results, Classifications, matches, matches, web, television, etc.)
  - Participants will be required to have an adequate presence in the Game Room and at the Closing Ceremony.
